

Spain / España, report 2015

Our 2014 Annual Assembly and the preparatory meetings were organized by the Orquesta de Valencia on 7 and 8 of March at the Palau de la Música (Concert Hall) of this Mediterranean city. The first day, as usual, was devoted to the meetings of the working groups. We had also a Round Table about the recent closure (2013) of the public TV and radio stations of the region of Valencia and the future of the huge amount of endangered audiovisual documents collected and produced by them from 1987 on.

The assembly elected a new board, with Reynaldo Fernández as a President and Antonia Riquelme (former secretary) as Vice-president, both from Centro de Documentación de Andalucía; Cristina Martí, archivist of the Orquesta Nacional de España, as Secretary; and Nekane Zurutuza, archivist of the Orquesta Sinfónica de Euskadi (Pays Basque) as Treasurer.

In 2014, we had 145 members: 77 institutions and 69 individuals, almost the same as last year. One of the main questions discussed was the need to broaden the modalities of membership of Aedom in order to facilitate the arrival of new professionals and stop the loss of members who are temporarily unemployed.

One of the main tasks proposed for 2014 was to digitize all the past publications of Aedom, the bulletins as well as the books, issued in the last twenty years, and to offer them to our members through our web page in 2015. The web page of Aedom was also comprehensively renewed in 2014.

Working groups

In 2014, the Access to Music Archives (AMA) group worked on an agreement with the representatives of the Spanish Church in order to get updated information on the different music archives kept by this religious institution. This information will be very valuable for the AMA because reports on these archives are now too old and incomplete. Many of the archives have been professionally cataloged recently and so the data have been improved.

The Working Group of Orchestra Archives, always very active, enhanced their database, Atril, a catalogue of Spanish Symphonic Music, through an agreement with SGAE (Society of Authors and Music Publishers), which represents the performing rights of music and theater works in Spain. The society provided funding to increase the contents of symphonic music from the region of Valencia in Atril. Other regional agreements will follow in the future.

Our group on Music Iconography has been working on its database which is now available to the public online (http://iconografia.aedom.org/)

The Commission of Sound Recordings of Aeom has been working this year on the creation of a union catalog of sound recordings trade catalogues. These kinds of trade catalogues are an essential tool for the cataloging of old recording materials. These catalogues are scarce and also very expensive. Our union catalog will help to locate existing catalogues; it also shows the catalog itself when it is digitized and online. The name of the union catalog is Matriz and it is now available in our web (http://www.aedom.org/matriz)

In the IAML 2014 summer conference in Antwerp, Jon Bagüés, director of Eresbil (Archive of Basque Music) and former vice president of IAML, was elected new chair of the Outreach Committee of our international association.

Publications

Our yearly *Boletín DM* reflects some of our yearly activities. This year we have published issue No. 18. We have changed our editorial board as well as our publication standards and evaluation
