
Q10 What was your opinion of the conference bag and its content?






Q15 Would you recommend your colleagues in your home country to attend the IAML congress?





Q19 What is your IAML membership status?




Q20 If you are an individual member, are you?



Q21 In what type of institution do you work (or did you work before retirement)?




