Board meetings held during the year

Board had a meeting on July 6, 2017 in Warsaw at the Warsaw Public Library (all members were present) to summarize the activities, including plans for the future.

The new board of the Polish National Branch of IAML had a meeting on March 13, 2018 in Katowice. President Hanna Bias invited the board to the Karol Szymanowski Academy of Music Library in Katowice. The deliberations were devoted above all to the preparations of the IAML Congress to be held July 14-19, 2019 in Kraków.

The next meeting is planned on June 21, 2018 in Warsaw at the Warsaw University Library.

Annual branch meetings

16th National Conference of Music Librarians "Musical treasures of libraries - provenance, problems, promotion" and the 7th National Conference of Sound Libraries "Archiving - Rescue for Phonographic Monuments"

A three-day programme at the conference titled 16th National Conference of Music Librarians "Musical treasures of libraries - provenance, problems, promotion" and the 7th National Conference of Sound Libraries "Archiving - Rescue for Sound Monuments" was rich in presentations, discussions and interactive dialogues.

The conference was attended by 56 participants from 36 institutions.

Branch membership figures

The Polish National Branch has 20 members (17 institutional and 3 individual).

This year two Polish libraries decided to become institutional members of IAML: the Polish Academy of Sciences - Library in Gdańsk and the Feliks Nowowiejski Academy of Music Library in Bydgoszcz.

The board plans to send official letters with new IAML leaflet to music libraries to gain new members.

Branch activities

Participation in IAML congresses has become an important element of the international activity of the Polish National Branch. 11 delegates from Poland took part in the IAML 2017 Congress in Riga; they presented 8 papers and 1 poster.

16th National Conference of Music Librarians "Musical treasures of libraries - provenance, problems, promotion" and the 7th National Conference of Sound Libraries "Archiving - Rescue for Phonographic Monuments". The conference was held at the Karol Lipiński Academy of Music in Wrocław on November 20-22, 2017. It was organized by the Karol Lipiński Academy of Music Library in Wrocław, Section of Music Libraries of the Polish Librarians Association - Polish National Group of IAML and Sound Libraries Section of the Polish Librarians' Association. It is worth mentioning that the Conference took place in the year of the 100th Anniversary of the Polish Librarians' Association.

Branch decided to organize workshops concerning cataloguing photographs held in music archives. It is planned for October 2018 at the headquarters of the Karol Szymanowski Academy of Music Library in Katowice.
