Branch educational activity

Under the name Zenei könyvtári ismeretek („Skills for Music Librarians”), our 120-hour education programme’s modules have been excelled by a total of 105 students. They are: county and city music librarians, colleagues of archives and music school teachers.

Our new module called A zeneirodalom csúcspontjai könyvtáros szemmel („The Peaks of Music Literature Through the Librarian’s Eye”) was offered by the Könyvtári Intézet in September 2020. The programme’s venue was the Országos Idegennyelvű Könyvtár securing the necessary audio and visual technology. Because of the pandemic situation only 8 students took part and finished the course.

RILM and RISM contributions

The Hungarian RILM and RISM works are coordinated by the AIBM Magyar Nemzeti Csoport and sponsored by the Nemzeti Kulturális Alap (National Cultural Fund of Hungary). Our organisation turns in a new application each year and commissions outside professionals to complete the tasks.

Unfortunately, in 2020 due to the lack of tenders we were unable to get support, so our RILM and RISM activities were stopped.
