### **Fontes (see report from Jim Cassaro)**

According to the Treasurer's report, 2023 royalties to date from various vendors for electronic access to the journal total \$20,498; 2022 royalties totaled 19,385.70. This is an important source of income for the association.

IAML recently signed an agreement with RILM FT for use of the journal in its database.

Claims:

The extension of claim period due to pandemic disruptions has ended as of 1 Jan 2023. Also, beginning with Volume 70 (2023), claims will be accepted between 3 to 6 months following the announcement of the issue on IAML-L. (The previous claim policy remained in effect through Vol. 69 no. 4, for which the claim period ended on 15 June 2023.) Replacements are shipped four times a year in March, June, September, and December. We hope the new policy will provide more clarity and ability to anticipate shipments for all members.
