Additional comments

In 2024, we used an online meeting system for all branch and board meetings to address cost constraints and increase participation of members in remote areas. The online system increased the flexibility of meeting holding. However, it eliminated opportunities for face-to-face interaction among members, making informal communication a little difficult.

Currently, the board members' cost-saving efforts allow the branch to operate without financial deficit. Still, the recent yen depreciation against the euro has increased the total sum of payments sent to headquarters from membership dues, putting pressure on the branch's budget.
