From 28 July to 2 August 2013, IAML (Austria) hosted the 2013 International Conference in Vienna. The conference was attended by nearly 400 delegates. Working sessions took place on the campus of Vienna University. The social programme included the Opening Ceremony in the City Hall's courtyard, two concerts at the Musikverein (Brahms Hall) and the Schönbrunn Castle Theatre, a choice of seven musically themed excursions, and the Farewell Dinner at Palais Ferstel.

The two regular working meetings of the Austrian National Branch were held in Autumn 2013 and in Spring 2014 and both meetings focused on IAML (Austria)'s contribution to the Working Group on the Access to Music Archives Project. The Autumn 2013 meeting on 5 November was hosted by the Library of the Anton Bruckner Private University for Music, Drama and Dance in Linz. The Spring 2014 meeting, 7 May, was held at the Vienna Philharmonic Orchestra's Archive.

During the past year, IAML (Austria) has lost and gained one member respectively, totalling 1 personal and 26 institutional members. The current Board is made up of President Thomas Aigner (Vienna City Library); Vice President Sabine Reiter (Music Information Center Austria); Secretary Stefan Engl (Austrian National Library); and Treasurer Thomas Leibnitz (Austrian National Library).
