

Grove Online Advisory Board Report

UpdateGMO

Six years ago, in response to feedback from scholars, Grove Online launched UpdateGMO, a major program to ensure that Grove content remains authoritative and useful to researchers. The March 2016 update included 53 articles that were revised or newly commissioned through this program. Entries for the Southeastern and East Central Europe Update Project constituted the majority of these articles. Jim Samson, Professor Music at Royal Holloway, University of London, and Grove contributor, is now acting as Editor in Chief of the project. A partial list of revised articles in this update include Boulez, Pierre, Byzantine chant, Concert de la Loge Olympique, Concert Spirituel, Greene, Maurice, Grunenwald, Jean-Jacques, Kusser, Johann Sigismund, Nyman, Michael (Laurence), Paris, \$IV, 2: 1723–89: Concert life, Sammartini, Giovanni Battista, and Sitsky, Larry [Lazarus].

The addition of 245 new articles to Grove Music Online from the second edition of The Grove Dictionary of American Music (AmeriGrove), edited by Charles Hiroshi Garrett has been completed. The first edition (1986) is widely considered the definitive reference work on the subject, and while some of the topics in this update appeared in the first edition, all are completely new to Grove Music Online and have been updated for the project.
