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Thesaurus Basics

- A type of controlled vocabulary
- Concepts are represented by terms
- Three kinds of relationships
 - equivalence (between terms)
 - hierarchical (between concepts)
 - associative (between concepts)
- Support information retrieval



Use of Thesaurus

- Search expansion
- Suggestion of alternative search terms
- Support for clustering or other means of refining a search
- Identification of common spelling mistakes
- Automatic indexing








Index terms by category

- Decide on the top-level categories
- Group index terms into those categories
- Develop hierarchies for each category
- Review and adjust categories and hierarchies




Filter Relationships




Future Work

- User interface, thesaurus API, SPARQL endpoint, etc.




