








Bohuslav Martinů Institute


- Collects documents to all Martinů compositions (over 400 works)
- Published scores and related literature available in IBM Library
- Non-published documents registered and described in Online Database
 - Autograph scores, historical reproductions, proofs etc.
 - Letters written by Martinů and addressed to him, also letters concerning Martinů, his work, performances, publishing proces etc. (9000 letters in total)
 - Photographs (over 700 pictures)
 - Concert programmes, staging documentation, photos from performances...
 - Rare audiovisual materials






Bohuslav Martinů Institute

- Does not own almost any historical documents
- Collects copies of Martinů related documents in one place (originals are scattered in many collection in Europe and US)
- Makes them accessible through Online Database




Unique sources and oral history

- Documents from private collections of friends of Bohuslav Martinů
- Recordings of interviews with people remembering Martinů (for example Charles Rosen talking and playing Martinů)

I think you came influence them, it is not very often I am making for spmething. Thank you.


Give my best regards to Tibor and Marika and to all our friends there. We are still in N.Y., if fait chaud. I hope you have sive time in Europe and in Paris.


