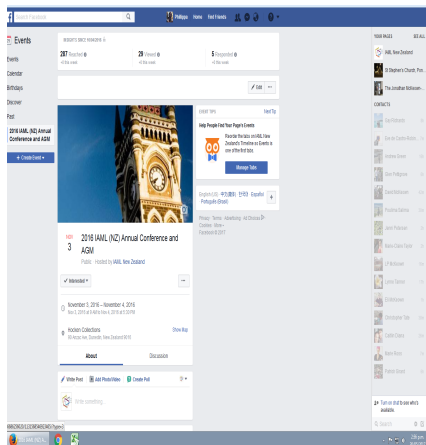


IAML New Zealand National Report Summary

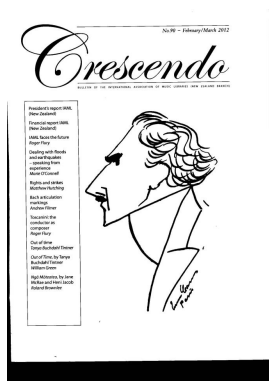
Seminar
