Passage-Level Retrieval for Music

We have a large collection, from music libraries around the world, of ~500,000 images of pages of music from early printed collections.

We want to be able to do two main things:

1. Find pages of music similar to a query page (*document-level* retrieval)
2. Find occurrences of a specific musical pattern in all of these pages (*passage-level* retrieval of note-sequences)

We pre-create a *search index* because of scale. This results in fast searches, but at the expense of needing to define similarity measure ahead of time. Close analogy with Google Books, but indexing *musical* content, not text

Full-text searching of musical scores

Compared to scans, there is a shortage of machine-readable music notation
small collections of transcriptions, RISM incipits

We can automatically extract music from images using software

Google Books uses Optical Character Recognition (OCR)

We use Optical Music Recognition (OMR, Aruspix)

Optical Music Recognition (OMR)

Two types of OMR errors:

1. those which affect a single note or symbol
2. those which affect all subsequent notes

Type 2 errors are more serious. They come in two forms, so we sidestep them:

Optical Music Recognition (OMR)

There are two types of errors that have a lasting effect:

1. Rhythmic errors (everything afterwards is offset in time)
2. Clef errors (everything afterwards is offset in pitch)


Workarounds:

1. Ignore rhythm
2. Use relative pitch – and ignore accidentals ('diatonic pitch')

Minimal Absent Words

A technique from genetics research, which we modified to work with pitch sequences

Identifies sequences from an alphabet which are *not present* in the document

Works well for full page to full page search, even in the presence of some OMR errors

Not as useful for other types of searches:

Note sequences / phrases / incipits (especially with OMR errors)

Sometimes some parts have multiple works on the same page

No metadata-based search



Moving from a proof of concept

Update of the underlying software used to perform searches

Apache Solr

Optimised for text search (works well with a-z for intervals)

faster than our previous technique and scalable

easier to try new types of searches and add new similarity metrics

capability to do text search on metadata



Public API

Search automatically in bulk without needing to use the interface

Search for page of music

Upload image

Upload MusicXML / MEI

Manually providing a sequence of notes on the page

Search for note sequences / phrases

Talk to us if you want access to this

Search by sequence of notes (phrases)

Services such as RISM have incipit search, which has been a standard way of identifying works

However cadences/ends of works are also interesting
- we have all notes so we can also search for these

However, OMR transcription errors also need to be considered

Other techniques from information retrieval on text documents can help here



Metadata search

By importing metadata from existing databases (library catalogue, DIAMM, Cantus, RISM, ...) we can provide tools to more easily navigate the collection

- works by a composer

- works based on their catalogue number

- works by vocal part

How can we provide search without re-creating existing databases?


