



United States, report 1993

The U.S. Branch convened in February in San Francisco for its 1993 annual meeting, which was held in conjunction with the annual meeting of the Music Library Association (MLA). The board met earlier the same week and again during the IAML annual conference in Helsinki.

The branch has extended an invitation to IAML to meet in the San Francisco Bay Area within the next few years; the year will be dependent upon the schedule of other sites.

A letter was sent this fall to selected current and former members of our branch soliciting any papers they may have that would be appropriate for our archive at the University of Maryland-College Park.

Diane Parr Walker has accepted appointment as our new representative to the U.S. RILM Governing Board, which governs the operations of the U.S. RILM office located at Cornell University under the direction of Lenore Coral.
