Alternatively, the prize (5.000 Euros) will be given to whom will find another musical composition, which, according to the final judgement of the editor of the magazine MUSICA, will give a significant contribution to the understanding and the knowledge of Zanni's music. The musical works and documents that will eventually be found, must be sent by registered mail not later than January 31st, 2016 to the magazine MUSICA (via Tonale 60, 21100 Varese - Italy).
